



The "BLUE CARD": A Pathway To Citizenship for Farm Workers

The "Agricultural Worker Program Act of 2017" is a federal bill that gives an opportunity for farm workers to legalize. The bill was introduced in the Senate by Senator Dianne Feinstein (S. 1034) and in the House of Representatives by Congressman Luis Guterierrez (HR 2690).

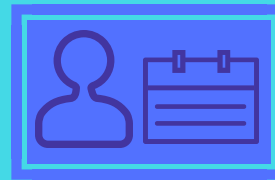
Step 1: Qualify



Work in the fields for at least **100 days** (in total) in the last **2 years**

**Complete other requirements, including a background check, no felony conviction, pay an application fee, etc.*

Step 2: Blue Card



Receive a **work permit & protection from deportation**-

including members of your family!

Option A:



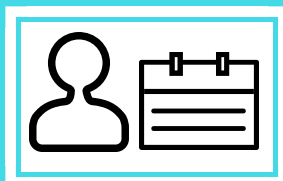
Continue working in the fields for **100 days/year** for **5 years**

Option B:



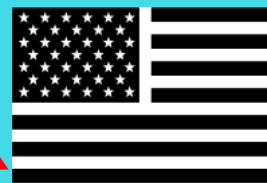
Continue working in the fields for **150 days/year** for **3 years**

Step 3: Residency



You can qualify to become a **legal permanent resident**

Step 4: Citizenship



Complete the naturalization requirements to become a **citizen!**
